

## All Market Medicaid Managed Care Grid

The following grid depicts profiles Medicaid managed care programs on state basis as of July 2011. Program changes projected through 2013 are presented. 37 markets in 2011 offered Medicaid Managed Care MCO models; and by year end 2013, there will be 39 markets. In 2011, the 37 markets accounted for 51%; and by year end 2013, the rate is expected to climb to 54%. States continue to expand Medicaid Managed Care by adding MCO models to population and geographies.
