

**Round 7 Questions and Answers for
RFP Number 2013-CMFD-01**

Question	Response
<p>Question 1: We are in the process of writing up the results from our analysis of the data that was provided as part of the Alabama Medicaid Agency RFP 2013-CMFD-01. We note that Round 3 of the Q&A provided the following information:</p> <p>Question 25: Is there a prescribed format for presentation of the results of the 3 years of data?</p> <p>Answer: No. The expectation is that the results will be a high level presentation of the findings to include a summary of the details and type of issues identified. Extra consideration will be given to solutions presented that surface types of FWA previously unknown to the Agency.</p> <p>We are concerned about using personally identifiable information in summarizing the "details and type of issues identified" in our written response. Our plan is to provide general, non-identifiable results in our written materials and discuss more in-depth findings at the demonstration. Please let us know if this is an appropriate approach.</p> <p>We note that Amendment 7 specifically asks for a table of claims with member information. Until we have the details on how to securely transfer this information, we are unsure whether it would be appropriate to include that level of detail in our report. Please let us know what is permissible.</p>	<p>“Personally identifiable information (PII) must be included as a part of the Detailed Line Item Report (Attachment N – Amendment 7). Failure to provide PII may result in the Proposal being classified as “non-responsive” and may be rejected as described in Amendment 7.</p> <p>Attachment N must not be included as part of the hardcopy Proposal.</p> <p>Vendor must include Attachment N as part of the softcopy CD/DVD or USB flash drive and must password protect the spreadsheet. The password for Attachment N must be emailed to Jacqueline Thomas at jacqueline.thomas@medicaid.alabama.gov by May 5, 2014 by 5pm CDT. Disclosure of Proposal Contents procedures are defined in Amendment 7.</p>
