Dear Mr. Arant:

On behalf of MedMetrics Health Partners, Inc. (MedMetrics), a non-profit, full service pharmacy benefit manager (PBM), with Public Sector Partners, Inc. (PSP) as its sole member, and affiliated with the University of Massachusetts Medical School and University of Massachusetts Memorial Medical Center, I am pleased to submit the enclosed response for the Alabama Medicaid Pharmacy Clinical Support Invitation to Bid (ITB). In response to the ITB I state the following:

b. MedMetrics has received no addendum to this ITB.

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- c. MedMetrics will be the prime contractor for this project. If awarded this contract, MedMetrics will engage as a subcontractor the University of Massachusetts Medical School Clinical Pharmacy Services (CPS) in order to satisfy the requirements of this ITB. The percentage of work, as measured by percentage of total contract price, to be performed by MedMetrics shall be 60 %. MedMetrics will assume sole and exclusive responsibility for all of the contractor responsibilities and work indicated in the ITB (including any and all addenda).
- d. As a foreign corporation, MedMetrics has applied for and has been granted a current Certificate of Authority to do business in Alabama issued from the Alabama Secretary of State.
- e. MedMetrics is in compliance with Affirmative Action and Equal Employment Opportunity regulations and I confirm that the MedMetrics does not discriminate in its employment practices with regard to race, color, religion, age (except as provided by law), sex, marital status, developmental disability, political affiliation, national origin, or handicap, and complies with all applicable provisions of Public Law 101-336, Americans with Disabilities Act.
- f. MedMetrics acknowledges and agrees to all of the rights of the Alabama Medicaid Agency contained in the provisions of this ITB.
- g. The prices proposed have been arrived at independently without consultation, communication, or agreement with any other bidder or competitor for this procurement.
- h. MedMetrics, through its duly authorized representatives, has in no way entered into any arrangement or agreement with any other bidder or competitor which could lessen or destroy free competition in awarding the contract sought by the ITB.
- i. Unless otherwise required by law, the prices quoted shall not be knowingly disclosed by MedMetrics, directly or indirectly, prior to award of the contract, to any other bidder or to any competitor.
- j. MedMetrics has not and will not make any attempt to induce any other person or firm to withhold or submit a proposal for the purposes of restricting competition.
- k. I am duly authorized to make decisions on behalf of the MedMetrics as to the prices quoted.
- l. MedMetrics has not employed anyone, other than a bona fide employee working solely for MedMetrics, in soliciting or securing this contract.
- m. No person or agency has been employed or retained to solicit or secure the proposed contract based on an agreement or understanding for a commission, percentage, brokerage, or contingent fee.
- n. MedMetrics, and any subcontractors, will maintain a drug-free workplace.

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- o. I hereby certify that neither it nor its principals is presently debarred, suspended, proposed for disbarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from participation in this contract by any federal department or agency.
- p. MedMetrics, including its affiliates, has not unilaterally and willfully terminated any previous review contract prior to the end of the contract term with a state or federal government and has not had a contract terminated by a state or federal government for cause, prior to the end of the contract term, within the last five years.
