Frequently Used Terms and Acronyms:

Integrated Care Networks (ICN) – One or more statewide organizations of healthcare providers, with offices in each regional care organization region, that contracts with Alabama Medicaid to provide Medicaid benefits to individuals who have been deemed eligible for Nursing Home care or Home and Community Based Services.

Regional Care Organizations (RCO) - An organization of health care providers that contracts with Alabama Medicaid to provide a comprehensive package of Medicaid benefits to enrollees in a defined region of the State

Long-Term Care (LTC) - a range of services and support for your personal care needs. Most long-term care is not medical care, but rather help with basic personal tasks of everyday life, sometimes called activities of daily living (such as bathing, dressing, walking).

Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) – Services that Medicaid beneficiaries can receive in their own home or community, as an alternative to nursing home care for those at risk of nursing home placement.
